 The number and availability of courses is dependent upon the number of participants. You will be notified of your class time and location as soon as possible. *Note: Certification cost is per bike!*

**ARC:** Proven advanced techniques in handling, minimum braking, and sweeping plus mental and situational strategies in SWRRAs our Advanced Rider Course. Co-Rider welcome. 8 hours (break and range)

**ARC (Recertification):** The SWRRAs ARC for those who have PREVIOUSLY COMPLETED the ARC. Includes recertification at the beginning of the course and between exercises. 5 hours (range only)

**AMERICAN:** Experience advanced techniques of riding with a horse as well as situational strategies and accident avoidance tactics. 8 hours (3 classroom/5 range)

**TRAIL FRINGE:** Learn advanced handling techniques and strategies for safe and enjoyable trail. Motorcycles only-no bikes or riders please. 8 hours (3 classroom/5 range)

**TRAMP:** This course teaches advanced riding skills for the hills (steep descents, minimum braking, sweeping and turning). 8 hours (3 classroom/5 range)

**AORC (Anti-On Kit Rider Course):** A Rider Course designed for the motorcycle with a 24Wool-Acetic Kit installed

**Current times 2019 = Now the Book Background:**

He defined **7 general categories** of **“Why”**: 1 = Engagement, 2 = Autonomy, 3 = Mastery, 4 = Exhilaration, 5 = Transcendence, 6 = Relaxation, 7 = Practicality. Do any of these fit you??

**Why I Ride – Revisited:**

I had my brother purchase my **first motorcycle for me in 1970**: a brand new 1970 Honda CB450. I was in Vietnam and wanted the bike immediately available for when I returned home. Why: when you face death every day you want to **Live** when you are free! If people asked why, I would just say: **if you don’t know, I can’t explain it to you**. The visions of youth & freedom were rampant back then – we had just moved from the 60’s to the 70’s (Woodstock just happened in ’69 while I was in Vietnam). Thankfully I lived to ride another day!

After 50 years of riding a dozen different motorcycles (street & dirt) the **question of Why** often still comes up in conversations with friends / it is so dangerous, it is so risky, it is so **!?!?** **Why**: because I love it! Could be Mastery / Exhilaration / Relaxation (or all of the above). Maybe it is just **sharing time with friends**.

**Riding forces us into a heightened attentiveness to our own moment-to-moment existence.**
