RIDER EDUCATION COURSES
The number and availability of courses is dependent upon the number of participants. You will be notified of your class time and location as soon as possible. Note: Certification cost is per bike!

ARC: Proven advanced techniques in handling, maximum braking, and steering plus mental and situational strategies in SWRRAs own Additional Rider Course. Co-Rider welcome. 3 hours (street and range)

ARC (Recertification): The SWRRAs ARC for those who have PREVIOUSLY COMPLETED the ARC. Includes recertification at the beginning of the course and between exercises. 5 hours (range only)

AMERICAN: Experience advanced techniques of riding with a focus on skill as well as situational strategies and accident avoidance tactics. 3 hours (3 day weekend range)

TRAIL FRINGE: Learn advanced handling techniques and strategies for safe and enjoyable trail. Motorcycles only-no bikes or riders please. 3 hours (3 day weekend range)

TRAMP: This course teaches advanced riding skills for the hills (steep descents, maximum braking, steering and turning). 3 hours (3 day weekend range)

TRAMP/TRAIL FR: This course combines the Trail Rider Course (TRC) with some guided practice in handling a trailer. 3 hours (3 day weekend range)

TRC-R (Recertification): The SWRRAs TRC for those who have PREVIOUSLY COMPLETED the TRC. Includes recertification at the beginning of the course and between exercises. 5-10 hours (range only)

Vanguard Rider Course: A performance based course to be used in conjunction with 2-10 hour seminars to take separately

AORC (Anti-On Kit Rider Course): A Rider Course designed for the motorcycle with a 24Wool-Aid-on Kit installed

CPR/First Aid: This course is designed to teach and certify you in the basic principles of CPR and First Aid. 4 hours
