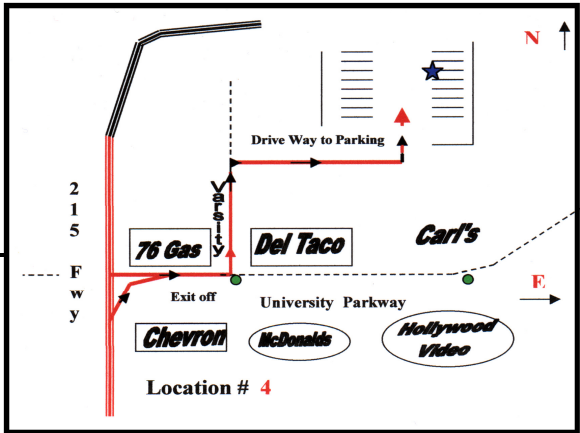
SLICE OF WRYYYY

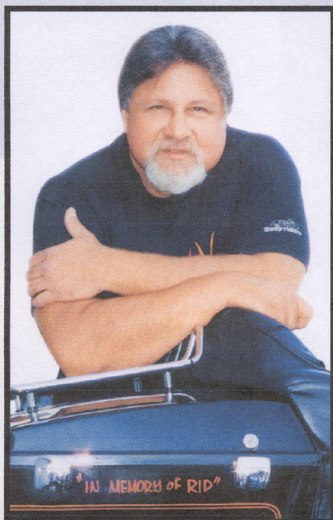

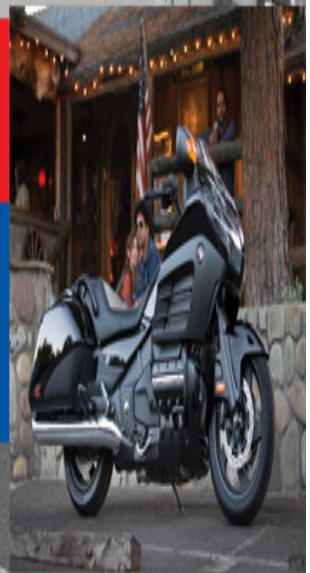
