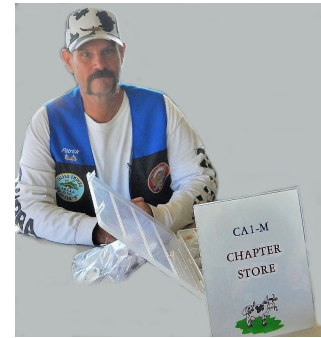

Saturday night at the Baymont Inn by Wyndham in Anderson, CA

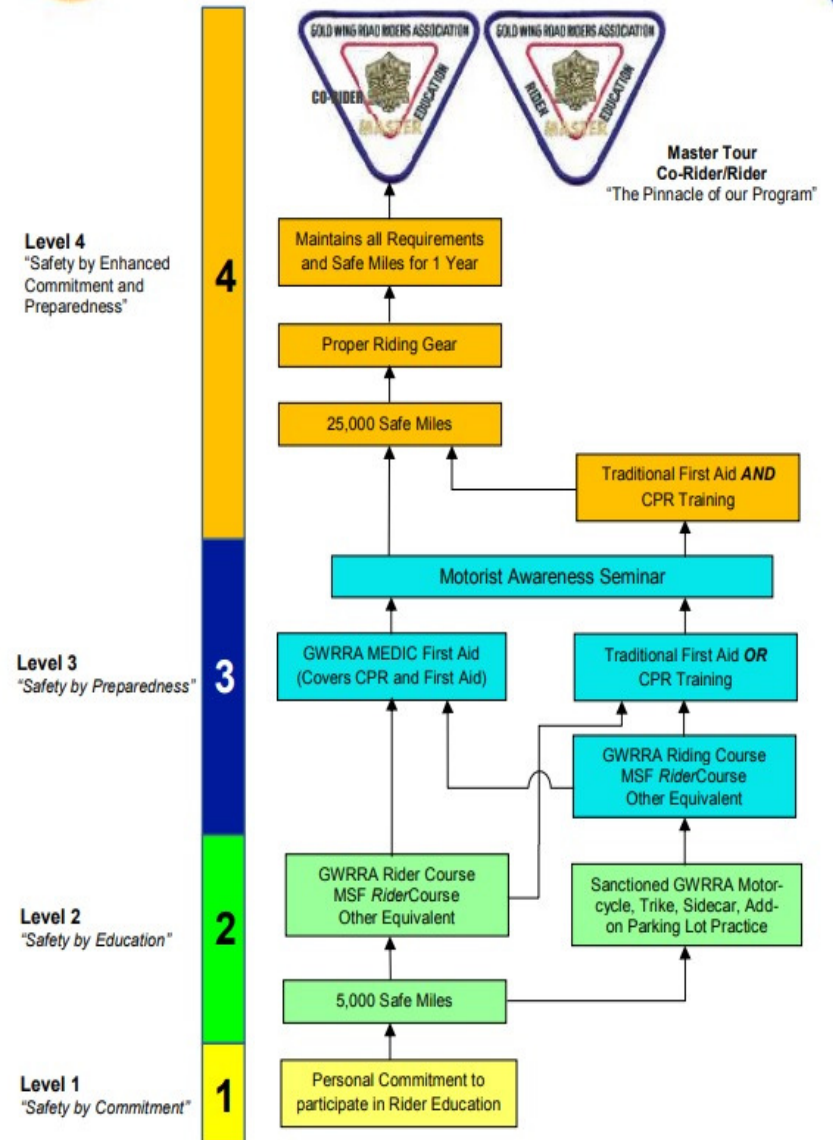

To all, for years now, I have been looking for an alternative to prevent spending \$900.00 to \$1500.00 for a Honda Goldwing CB radio.

Thanks to Sena technologies I found a way. Yet it may not be for all. However, with this set up using the Sena 20s Evo and above you can use bluetooth communication up to nine riders, listen to your music, gps and being able to hear and speak via CB radio.

For Honda Goldwings 2018 plus, you have to be ok not using the Apple CarPlay. Unfortunately Apple CarPlay interferes with the CB radio.

You must be willing to have the Sena unit attached to your helmets with inside speakers and microphone.

Also there are 3 other components that you will have to buy to be able to have this set up.

Ride streetcars, interurban electric cars, and trains on the Museum railway on our 100 acre campus. Pack a family picnic to enjoy in Holstrom Park. Visit the Museum's collection of more than 200 streetcars and railway vehicles to experience the early days of electric, steam, and diesel railway transportation in and around Los Angeles.

### All Aboard the Southern California Railway Museum Railway!

Ride streetcars, interurban electric cars, and trains on the Museum railway on our 100 acre campus. Pack a family picnic to enjoy in Holstrom Park.

Parking, Entry to Grounds, and Entry to Open Exhibits are **FREE\*** Select Trains and Trolleys run every Weekend and select Holidays between 9:15am and 4:00pm, except during special ticketed events – ride as many times as you like!

The Museum's operating Steam Engine Ventura County No.2 (VC2) is tentatively scheduled to run the third weekend of the month.

The scheduled Locomotive is generally posted to Facebook on Thursdays, but please note that the equipment schedule may change at any time due to required maintenance.

Left on Contour Ave leading to Juniper Flats Rd

Left on 74 (stoplight) for 2 miles to "comfort stop" at Shell Station 74/79 (= always a good idea)

Back West on 74 to Menifee Road - Left

Right on Case Rd

Left on Ethanac

Right on Goetz Rd

Left on Mapes

Right on Watson leads to Museum parking lot. The entry is free right now, so that is a great benefit for the members.

It is a another .5 miles to restaurants if members want to eat or get takeout for a picnic at the museum.
