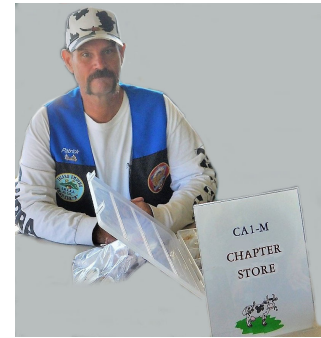

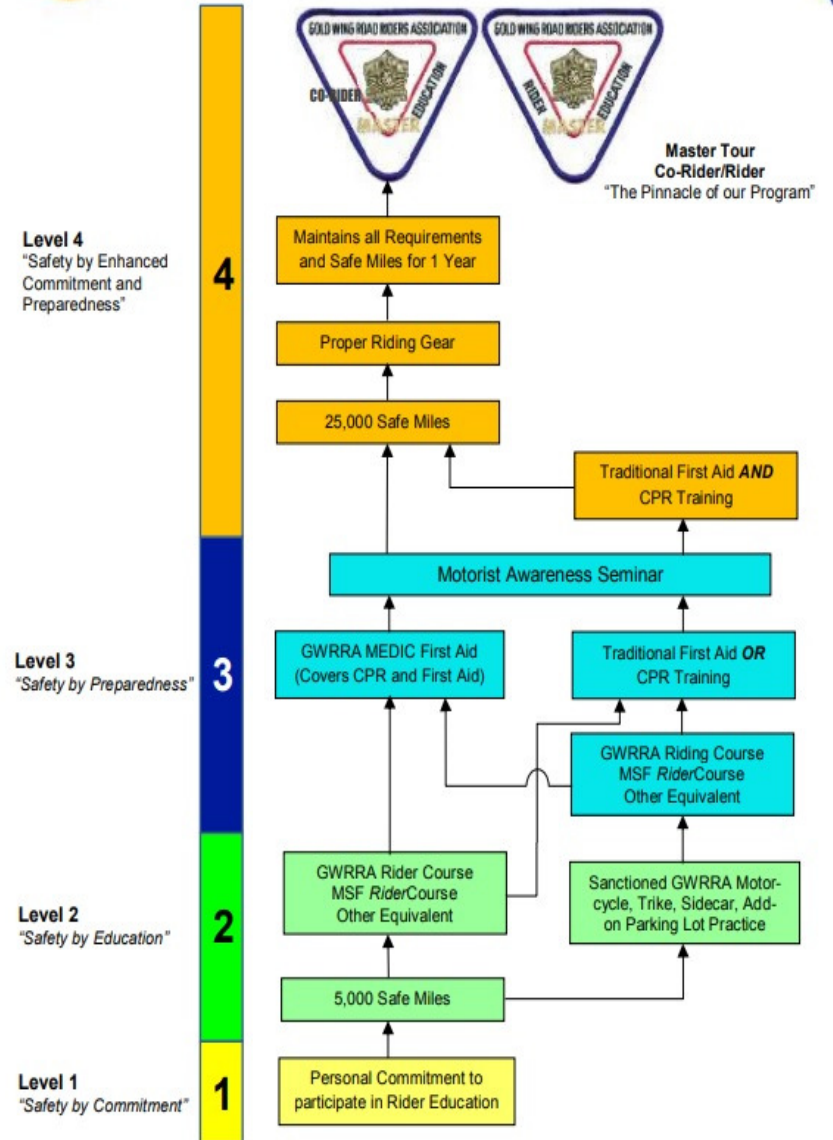

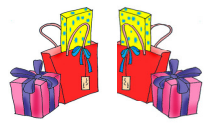
Russ Johnson:
