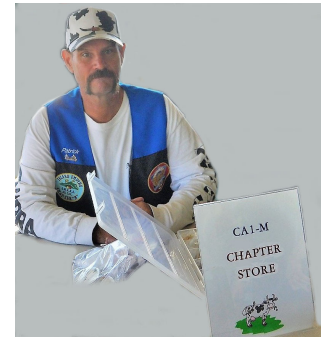

Saturday night at the Baymont Inn by Wyndham in Anderson, CA

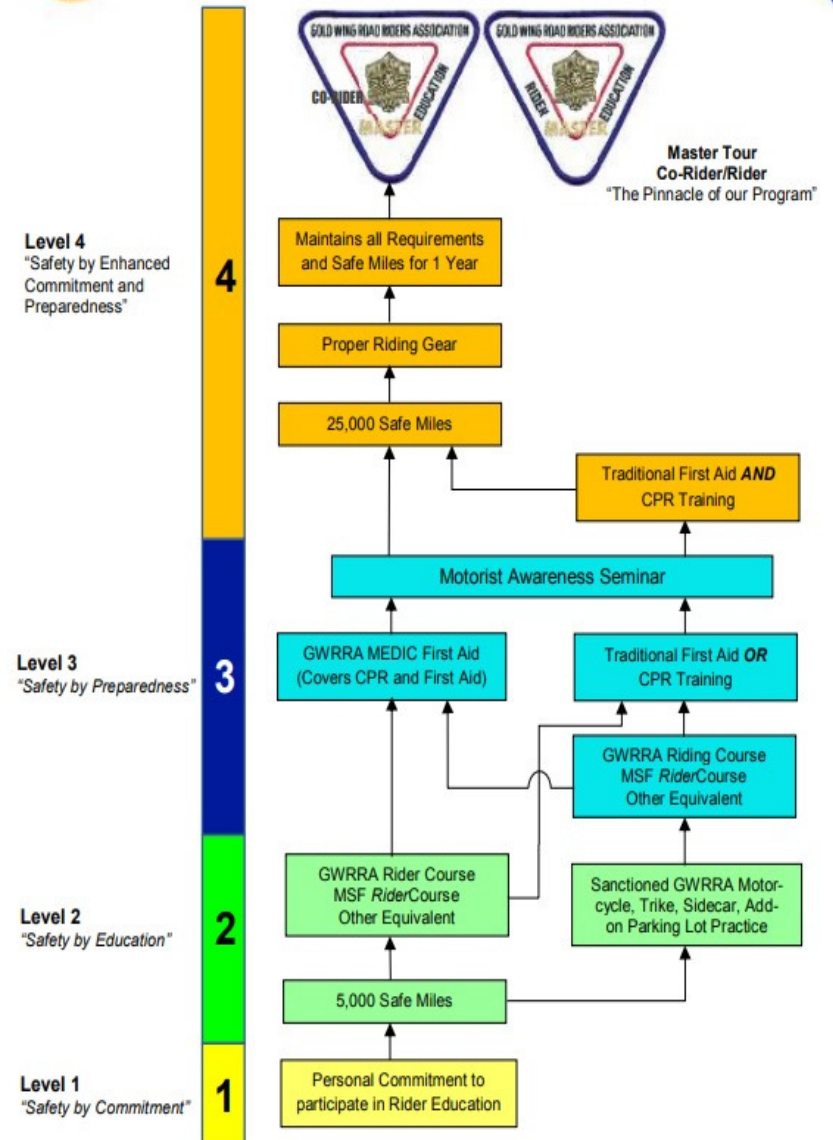
