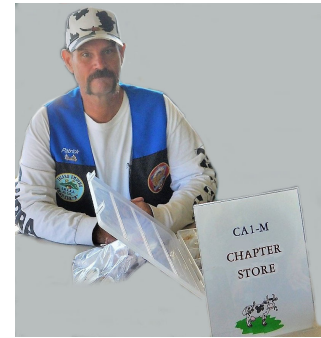

Not to be denied, 4 of the group rescheduled a ride to cover those missing roads – only to be denied again by snow in the mountains. If we couldn't go high, we would go LOW / off to Death Valley instead for our 3-day adventure: Mike Rand as Road Captain, Russ Johnson as Tailgunner, with Albert Young (1V) and Roger Taylor (1Q/M) enjoying center stage!

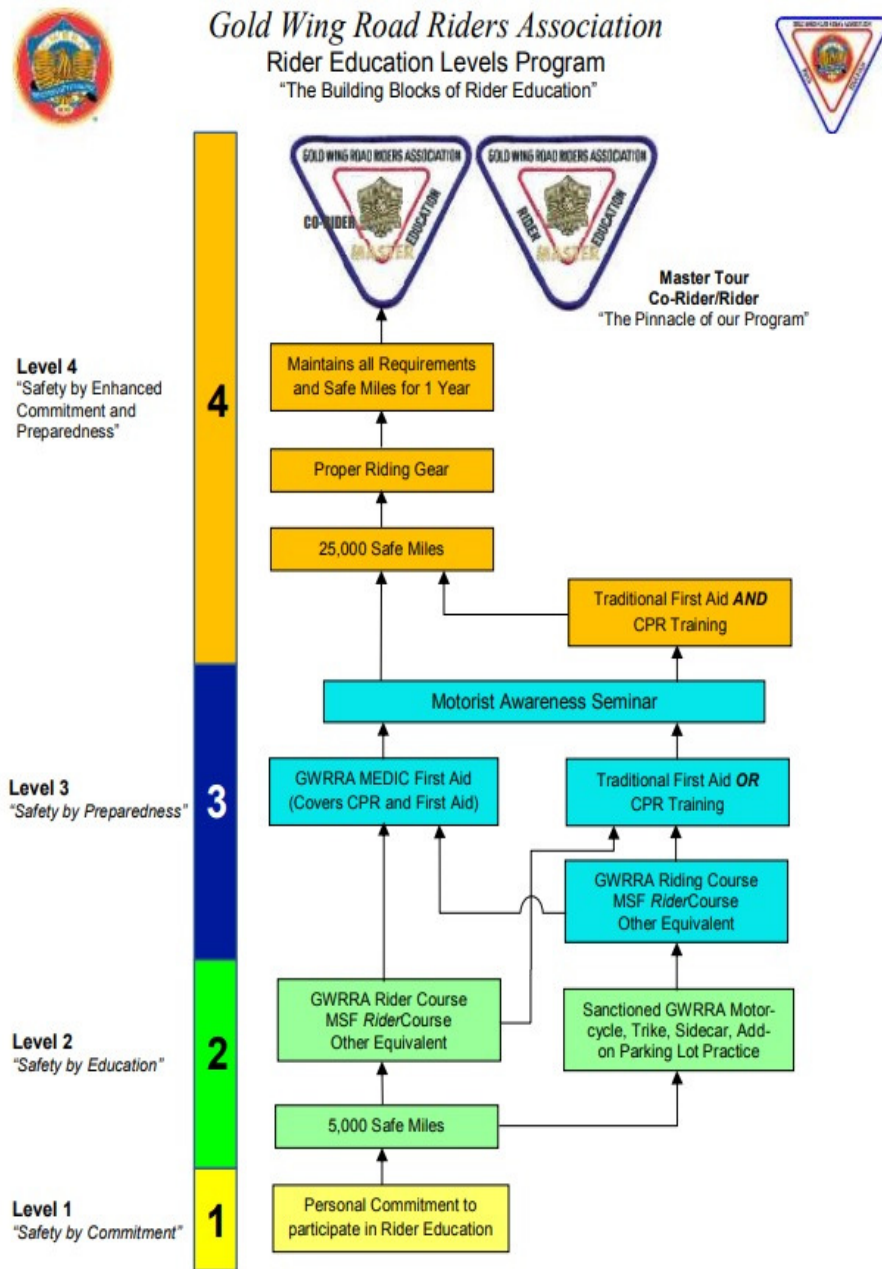
Mike mapped out a route from Victorville taking Route 66 all the way to Amboy; then we took Kelbaker Rd, through Kelso, and on to Baker, then picked up SR 127 to Shoshone and Charles Brown Hwy into Pahrump Nv.

Day 2 took us down to Bad Water: it's still 282' below sea level (really LOW); we continued over to the Artists Dr (a 10-mile loop to see its beauty). Our tour lead to Zabriskie Point, and then on up to Dante's View. The desert was in its glory after the recent rains and the views were about as good as they could be. We left Death Valley headed to Tonopah; just short of Beatty we turned left and visited Rhyolite Ghost Town. We stopped at the Beatty Candy Store to get some lunch, and headed north to on US-95 through Goldfield and finally we pulled into our Hotel in Tonopah (it just happened to be across the street from a Brewery/BBQ restaurant!).

Oh, did I mention the snow along the roads and the ice in the hotel parking lot.

Friday morning, we woke up to temps below freezing, but by the time we finished breakfast it was 32 when we left town; unfortunately, it got cooler as we headed across US 95 and then Hwy 6, temps stayed between 24 and 43.

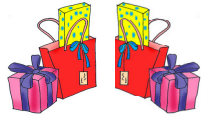
