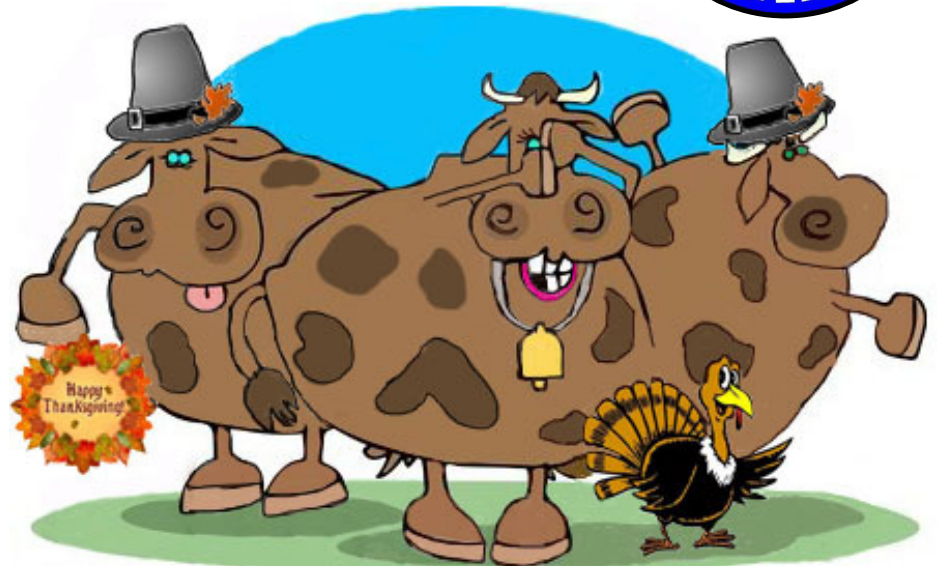

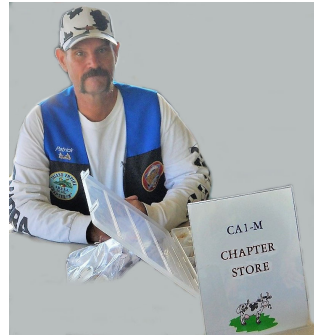

## The Fall Ride, the rest of the story.

So, after the first 2 days in last month's newsletter, the 6 of us rode back and forth across the Sierra's twice more on the way up. We took Hwy 4 across on Wednesday, then took 89 up over Monitor Pass, jumped on 395 up to Gardnerville, then up to Tahoe and turned south to 89 and then too 88 half way across then picked up several small local twisty roads to end up Placer-ville and spend the night in Auburn.

Thursday, we took Hwy 49 to Nevada City, then all the way to a different section of 89 through a huge mountain meadow above 6000 elevation, had lunch at the Polka Dot Diner in Quincy (recommended ) and then down Hwy 70 once back on the west side of the Sierra's we took a few local roads and went through Paradise. Note: the town is really doing a very good job of coming back from the fire that leveled most of the town. We then went  $\frac{1}{2}$  way back across the Sierra's on Hwy 32 to pick up Hwy 36 and follow it to our roughest road of the trip, but is led us to Manson and a road that was really neat for about 10 miles. At the end of that road we took Hwy 44 back to Redding and then cut off to our hotel in Anderson that would be the Hotel for the next three nights.

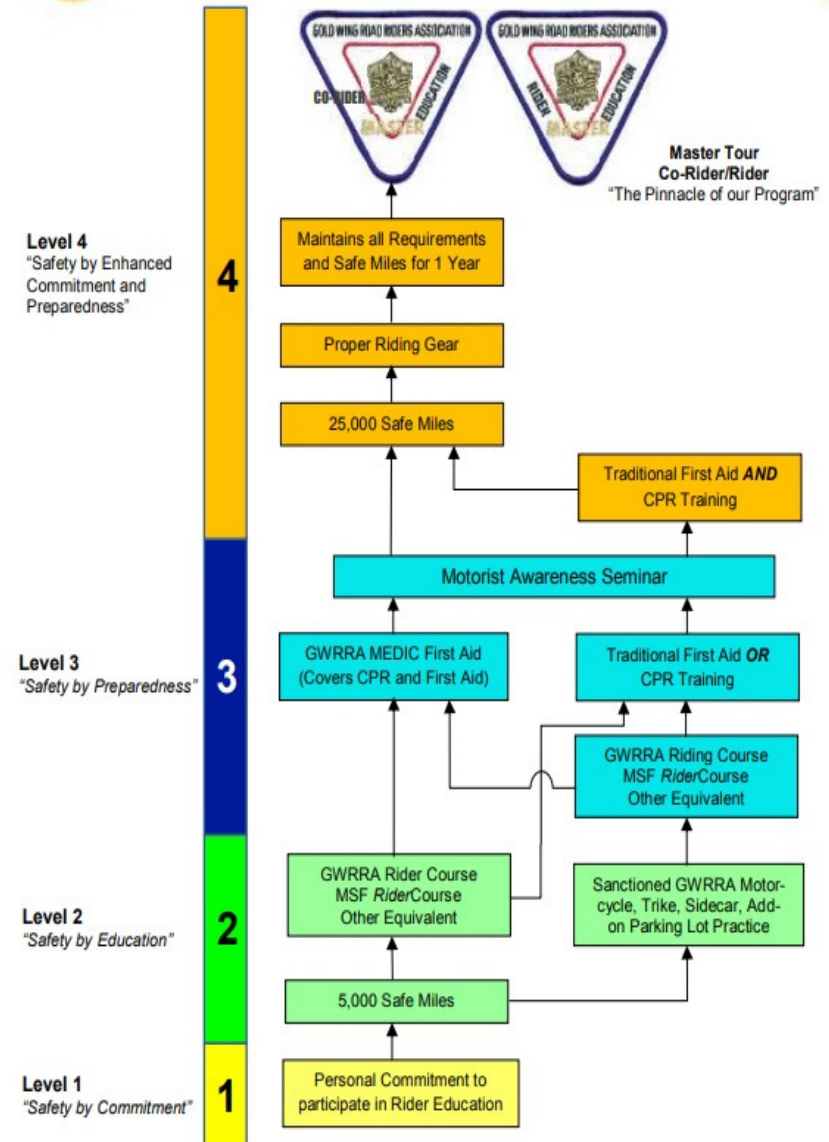
Friday, was Day One of the Fall ride and most of the guys went with the CA-2R Ride Rally. I went on the Fall Ride trip that took us to several counties. We all took Hwy 44 east to Lassen National Park, here the CA-2R Ride went into the park and explored it. The Fall Ride group consisted of 6 bikes continued East on 44 until it merged with another section of Hwy 89 then on Hwy 299 Eat all the way to Adin, CA. We turned around in Adin and went back as far at MacArthur taking Ca A-19 across to yet another section of Hwy 89. When we came to I-5 we took it south all the way back to Anderson and our hotel.

Saturday was the last day of the Fall Ride weekend, Don Kuellmer was leading the ride that took 299 West all the way to the 101 then they went north to Klamath before returning on the same route. I chose to ride the CA-2R Ride Rally group here because the took a whole bunch of new roads for me. Like Don's group we started on 299 taking it to Weaverville then took Hwy # north to Callahan. Then took Forest Route 42N17 along the Trinity River almost to Weed where we had lunch and then got on I-5 all the way back to the Hotel Room.

Starting next month, veterans and Gold Star families will be able to visit [national parks and other public lands](#) for free, under a new initiative from the Department of the Interior announced on Wednesday.

Active-duty service members and their families are already granted free access to those sites under existing department rules. The new announcement broadens that benefit to more than 20 million more individuals in recognition of their service and sacrifice on behalf of the country.

In a statement, [Interior Secretary David Bernhardt](#) said the move gives all veterans "free access to the iconic and treasured lands they fought to protect." The policy goes into effect starting on Veterans Day, Nov. 11.

Sunday found us beginning our ride home. We took Hwy 299 all the way to the 101 where Roger took the lead for a bit and gave us a guided tour of his hometown area. We had lunch in Samoa Cookhouse. We arrived late in the breakfast timeframe. You get "Breakfast" which is whatever they decide for that day in our case it was a huge slice of French toast, scrambled eggs, bacon and a drink. Dinner and lunch are served the same way. What they Make is what the serve. On Sunday both were Pork Roast but we left before they began serving that. Eventually after gassing up I lead the group down the 101 to Leggett, where we turned west and scrapped our pegs all the way to the coast on the PCH ending the day at Fort Bragg.

Monday we took the PCH all the way to Mill Valley at which time we lunched, and gassed up ,then crossed the Golden Gate, and followed the PCH to our Hotel in Monterey.

Tuesday was our final day and we rode together as a group all the way down to Ventura where we took Hwy 126 to I-5 at Valencia. As we pulled up to I-5 we said our goodbyes and soon Albert and I were riding through Santa Clarita, a short section of Bouquet Canyon, then over to Sierra Highway and onto CA-14 after a detour through Avenue S we got on CA-138 and split at Hwy 18, him going on 138 to home and me taking 18 across to home.

In total we road between 3300 and 3700 miles because of our different starting points and the rides we took in Redding. I got in 3600+ miles, over 9 days, with 6 friends that barely knew each other before we started this ride. As in our first 2 days we had several route departures because of fire. But we are all looking forward to a similar adventure in the future.

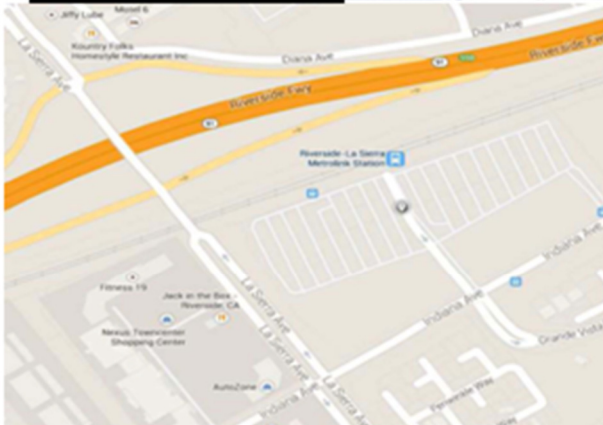

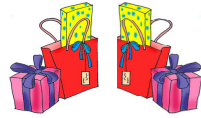

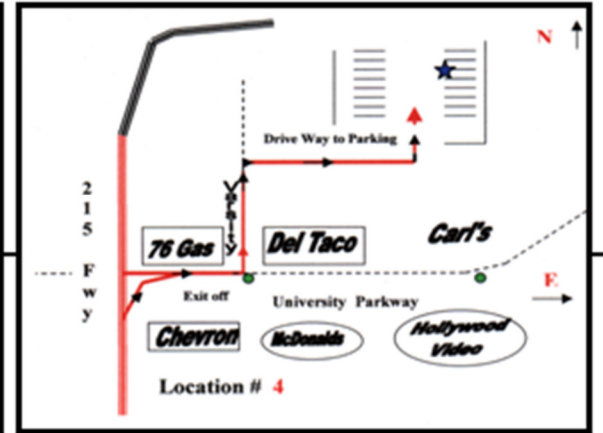
