Our Meeting in May will be moved up to May 2nd instead of the 9th since this is Mother's Day and The Pepper Steak Restaurant has asked us to move it.






Saturday night at the Baymont Inn by Wyndham in Anderson, CA

This will be a great opportunity to check out your mountain road skills. These are not all high-speed roads and will be taken at a reasonable pace.



Jerry, please feel free to send this info to all our chapter and to all chapters in the GWRR across our nation. To all, for years now, I have been looking for an alternative to prevent spending \$900.00 to \$1500.00 for a Honda Goldwing CB radio.

Thanks to Sena technologies I found a way. Yet it may not be for all. However, with this set up using the Sena 20s Evo and above you can use bluetooth communication up to nine riders, listen to your music, gps and being able to hear and speak via CB radio.

For Honda Goldwings 2018 plus, you have to be ok not using the Apple CarPlay. Unfortunately Apple CarPlay interferes with the CB radio.

You must be willing to have the Sena unit attached to your helmets with inside speakers and microphone.

Also there are 3 other components that you will have to buy to be able to have this set up.


