



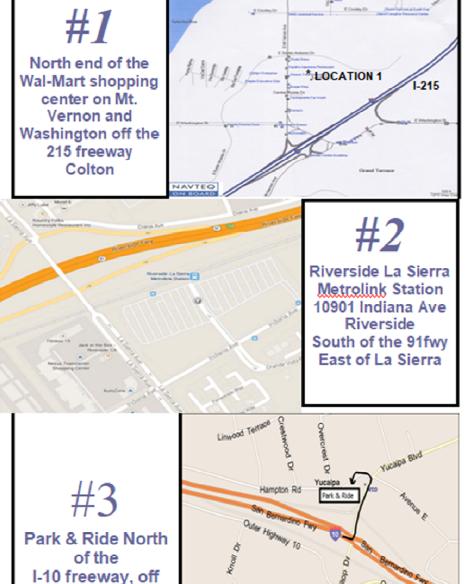








ALTERNATE LEAVE LOCATIONS FOR RIDES


