
Dealer Program - All forms are complete and will be on Oconnect by the time you read this. Below is a reminder of the program.

GWRRA will provide to a dealer



a special Membership application to GWRRA. #### Honda Yamaha of Redlands (hyr@hyredlands.com) TIP: Be Prepared to Ride

Always take a Tool Kit along when you go for a ride. You never can tell when it will come in handy. Use the tools to go over the bike occasionally and make sure no screws or bolts are loose. You should always have your owner's manual with the bike. It tells you where the fuse box is, in the unlikely chance a fuse blows. It may also tell you how to get a wheel off, should you have the misfortune of a flat tire. Flat tires are pretty rare occurrences on motorcycles, but they can happen. In this case, you can either get on the phone with us for assistance, or fix it yourself using a Tire & Tube Repair Kit. If you want to know how to do it, we recommend you practice at home, rather than have your first shot at fixing a flat alongside a deserted road in the middle of the night



# Gold Angels Motorcycle Drill Team

The Assistant Safety Officer of the Gold Angels assists the team Safety Officer with anything related to safety. This includes rider's motorcycle condition and the training field along with the layout. These two team positions fall onto the shoulders of one Roger Taylor.

1 bonus point for each bike or trike from the Visiting Chapter (bonus points can be awarded for every visit to a chapter's gathering or rally/event)


When a Chapter is visited, an officer from the Visited Chapter will initial the Score Sheet of the Visiting Chapter and write down the number of points earned.


