
Russ our new Ride Coordinator is going to try for 2 rides a month for now. When things open up their just may be some overnighters.




Saturday night at the Baymont Inn by Wyndham in Anderson, CA


This will be a great opportunity to check out your mountain road skills. These are not all high-speed roads and will be taken at a reasonable pace.
