

Three of our CA1M members have come down with COVID-19. Send your prayers to Ron and Dianne Hogle and our newest member Carlos Vasquez.





Mike mapped out a route from Victorville taking Route 66 all the way to Amboy; then we took Kelbaker

Day 2 took us down to Bad Water: it's still 282' below sea level (really LOW); we continued over to the

through Goldfield and finally we pulled into our Hotel in Tonopah (it just happened to be across the


street from a Brewery/BBQ restaurant!).
