While on the road one of the things That car drivers do that bother me is




In 1946, Pioneertown was founded by a group of Hollywood investors, including actors Roy Rogers and Gene Autry. They dreamed of creating an Old West set 125 miles east of Los Angeles that was actually a town worth visiting, with 1880s-style false-front facades but interiors that had stuff for visitors to see and do too. Up went (from the outside) frontier stables, saloons, and jails; inside, they housed ice cream parlors, bowling alleys, and motels. It wasn't a place just for tourists to enjoy though; more than 50 films and television shows were filmed here in the 1940s and '50s


While location shoots here have dwindled in the years since, you can still see mock gunfights on Mane Street. But the most happening place by far is Pappy and Harriet's Pioneertown Palace, which hosts surprisingly big-name live acts—Robert Plant and Leon Russell have played here, and more contemporary bands like Iron & Wine and CHVRCHES pass through as well. This must-see desert find also serves up awesome ribs, plus classic Santa Maria barbecue, burgers, sandwiches, and salads.

 California District Rally Ride: Thursday August 19 CA-1M
 (FUN with Friends in Visalia)

The District Rally starts early on Friday August 20 at the Wyndam Hotel and ends at noon on the Sunday August 22. The opportunities to enjoy a great weekend are everywhere! There are many structured activities sponsored by District, and there are wonderful riding opportunities in the local mountains. If you have the time, you should seriously consider sharing the event with all the GWRRA friends throughout the State. Check the Rally brochure for all the details – **Party Time**.

To make the weekend journey even more **enjoyable**, I have planned a spectacular back road ride to Visalia! You can certainly get to Visalia via the freeway in about 4 hours (yeah – a really fun 240 miles/not) or you can join me and take the scenic route! We will depart from **Location #1 at 8 AM** and start out on Hwy 15 / heading towards Hwy 395 and better roads (Butler Motorcycle Maps don't lie).

The **Sherman Pass** is a great way to get over the mountains - it is J41 just North of Pearsonville (140 miles); the pass is one of the most varied & scenic in the Sierras. The M99, more FUN, will take us over to the **Western Divide Hwy** (M190 = 220 miles) for a great ride in the **Sequoia National Monument** North to J37 and into Visalia (310 miles to the Wyndam hotel). The ride time will be about 8-9 hours including comfort stops and a lunch stop = more smiles per mile than the freeway! We will be there in time for Happy Hour!

To all, for years now, I have been looking for an alternative to prevent spending \$900.00 to \$1500.00 for a Honda Goldwing CB radio.

Thanks to Sena technologies I found a way. Yet it may not be for all. However, with this set up using the Sena 20s Evo and above you can use bluetooth communication up to nine riders, listen to your music, gps and being able to hear and speak via CB radio.

For Honda Goldwings 2018 plus, you have to be ok not using the Apple CarPlay. Unfortunately Apple CarPlay interferes with the CB radio.

You must be willing to have the Sena unit attached to your helmets with inside speakers and microphone.

Also there are 3 other components that you will have to buy to be able to have this set up.
