

Rider Education

One of the reasons why we were drawn to GWRRA in the very beginning was the wealth of information and classes on how you can improve your riding skills. I have been riding a motorcycle for 48 years and I am learning new skills all the time. Some riders get to the point where they think they have learned all there is to riding. That is when it gets dangerous. No matter how long you have been riding, you can ALWAYS pick up some new skills. And many times it can come from a brand new rider. How, you say-they just got out of a Basic Rider Course that may be teaching some new ideas. That is why GWRRA recommends that you renew your skills at least every 3 years with an ARC/ERC (Advanced Rider's Course/Experienced Rider's Course) or another such as StreetMasters.

Another reason not to get too confident-studies have concluded that every time you start riding a different motorcycle, it takes you 6 months to get used to it. That means, to be able to hit the right switches, buttons, controls and pedals in the dark or in an emergency without making a mistake.

Riding is a constant learning curve. The ones who think they know everything there is to know are frequently a liability to others around them. GWRRA's Rider Education offer some very informative classes and seminars. They are designed to be informative and funnot to intimidate or ridicule you for mistakes. We highly recommend that you take advantage of as many as you can. If there is an area that you would like some refreshing in, let us know.

So, lets get out there and have some fun. And above all, <u>Keep it</u> <u>safe out there!</u>




